Kevin keefe obit strongsville ohio

Reportedly, Kevin Keefe, a father of three kids from Strongsville, Ohio, shot and killed his wife before turning the pistol on himself. Keefe was the father of three girls. Dr. Cameron M. Ryba, the superintendent of Strongsville City Schools, sent an email to parents and staff members in his district informing them of the murder-suicide that had taken place in his town. He was overcome with grief and concerned for the welfare of the girls who were now without a parent. There have been serious repercussions as a result of a man who shot both himself and his wife. There is a need for deeper investigation into the circumstances surrounding the deaths of the two victims. A man named Kevin Keefe lives in Strongsville, Ohio, and he and his wife, Carrie Keefe, were tasked with the responsibility of looking after their three young daughters. The unfortunate event left the children without parents, and as a result, they are all considered to be orphans. The youngsters were enrolled in the local school system. A possible explanation for the events is that Kevin shot Carrie and then shot himself. The Law and Crime division has initiated contact with the Strongsville, Ohio, police department in an effort to get further information that will allow the investigation to continue in an appropriate way. Even though it is receiving a lot of attention, there is still a lot of mystery surrounding the couple and what took place. Kevin and Carrie's daughter reported the event to the authorities, who contacted 911. Carrie was found unconscious and lying on the floor when the police came, and Kevin had already been found dead when they arrived. The girls confessed to the cops that their father was the one who committed the crime. Because the specifics are still being investigated, it is impossible to conclude until the relevant authorities have provided their input. There seemed to be disagreement in the marriage before October of 2021, when Carrie filed for divorce. They decided to sell their residence on Calderdale Lane a week and a half ago due to their separation and divorce. According to the rumors circulated online, the murder could have been precipitated by an argument between the two parties. The incident has been referred to as a murder-suicide up to this point, even though the authorities have not verified this. One of the youngsters in the group was the one who started the murder of their mother with a gun and then shot themselves. Carrie was still alive when the police came, but despite their best attempts, they could not rescue her. She could not be saved despite the fact that she was still alive. On Saturday, a man and a woman were found dead in a home on Calderdale Lane, according to Cleveland 19. A 49-year-old man and a 42-year-old woman were both found shot inside the house. On Monday, the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner identified the 49-year-old as Kevin Keefe and the 42-year-old as Carrie Keefe. Carrie reportedly filed for divorce from Kevin in October 2021. Police said that they are investigating the case as a murder-suicide. Strongsville Police said in a press release that a 911 call came in just before 11:30 a.m. on Saturday reporting the deadly shooting. Authorities said they found Carrie Keefe and Kevin Keefe shot at the scene. Police said Kevin Keefe, the suspected shooter, was dead at the scene. Carrie Keefe was found unresponsive and dying. Responding paramedics tried to save the victim, but the mother of three daughters died at a nearby hospital. Police said that one of the girls was the 911 caller and identified her father as the shooter. JWJW reported that Carrie Keefe filed for divorce in October 2021. WOIO added that the estranged couple had as recently as 12 days ago agreed to sell their Calderdale Lane home. The shooting took place at that home just days ahead of a scheduled telephone meeting. An email from Strongsville City Schools Superintendent Dr. Cameron M. Ryba, which was posted online, said the murder-suicide was "tragic" and "devastating" in its "far-reaching" impact on the community and the Keefe children. The superintendent also said that crisis counselors would be available all day Monday. Police in Strongsville, Ohio, have released a heartbreaking 911 call made by a young girl reporting that her father had shot her mother and himself in a murder-suicide over the weekend. Law&Crime is not sharing the audio itself because it could identify the minor, but we will quote the back-and-forth between the clearly distraught caller and the dispatcher. As Law&Crime reported Monday, Strongsville Police said in a press release that a 911 call came in just before 11:30 a.m. on Saturday reporting the deadly shooting. Authorities said they found Carrie Mae Schlieper Keefe, 42, and Kevin Keefe, 49, shot at the scene. Following the 911 call, police said, Kevin Keefe was found dead at the scene and identified as the suspected shooter. Carrie Keefe was found unresponsive and dying. Tragically, the mother of three daughters—all of them enrolled in the local school district—died at a nearby hospital. The 911 call released by Strongsville Police provides more insight into how authorities identified the shooter. "My dad just killed himself and he shot my mom," the girl said. "It's very hard to hear you can you take me off speaker phone?" the dispatcher said. "Yes," the girl replied. "Okay, what's going on [at] Calderdale [Lane]," the dispatcher asked. "My dad just shot my mom and he killed himself," the girl said. "Your — did what?" the dispatcher answered. "My dad just shot my mom!" the crying girl shouted, her voice quivering. "Please hurry!" The dispatcher then asked the child caller where in the house her parents were located. "My mom's laying on the kitchen floor," the girl said. "He's laying by the stairs, just like right past the kitchen." The dispatcher then asked about whether the Keefe parents were still alive. "I think she's still breathing," the girl said of her dying mother. "She's still breathing." The girl said her mom was shot in the arm, right shoulder, and her waist. "Where's the gun at, do you know?" the dispatcher asked. "It's by my dad but I don't want to go over there," the girl responded. "Is he awake?" the dispatcher asked. "No, he's dead," the girl said. "He is dead? Aw," the dispatcher said. "Please hurry up, she's almost gone. I can't lose her," the caller said of her mom. "You said she's still breathing?" the dispatcher asked. "Barely, she's making weird sounds," the girl said, noting that her uncle was at the house and trying to help save her mom. "Do you know where they are?" the caller asked, referring to first responders. "I think she is going to die soon." "Please don't let her die, I can't be alone," the girl said. The call, which lasted for more than six minutes, ended with the sounds of children crying as first responders arrived at the Calderdale Lane home.
