It's been a long time since I last posted here and I have some good news to share with you all. Over the past year I have been hard at work creating multiplayer card games! I am pleased to introduce today: World of Card Games! You can play it here: currently has 3 games: Hearts, Spades and Go Fish! Multiplayer card games is one of the most highly requested features I have gotten over the years from World of Solitaire players. Just like World of Solitaire, it is free, no registration is required and there are no downloads or installs. Just beautiful, full screen, card gaming goodness :) Here are some screenshots: Current features include: Guided tutorials for each game Robot players Private Tables 8 decks 90+ wallpapers 100+ avatars! I am planning on adding many more games including: Euchre, Rummy, Whist, Canasta and more! I also want to add new features such as statistics, ratings, sound, leaderboards and more. Part of the reason I wanted to create World of Card Games was to develop a new "card game engine" that could support things I've wanted to do on World of Solitaire for a long time. This includes guided tutorials, iPad/tablet support and more. Eventually I hope to bring this new engine over to World of Solitaire, but that is far in the future as it takes a lot of time to do all this by myself :) Greetings! The update is now LIVE! New Stuff HD Cards Cards are now in glorious HD! They look especially great on high DPI "retina" displays. Long Stacks When a stack becomes too tall to fit on the screen, the cards now automatically squeeze themselves together to fit on the screen! Larger Cards Multiple games now feature larger sized cards! This is thanks to the long stack support. No longer do you need to choose between "Largest Size" or "Best Looking" as cards are now both of those things, all the time! Pause You can now Pause the game at any time! Game Save/Restore Games are now automatically saved at all times. If your computer crashes or loses power or you accidentally close the browser, you can simply "Restore" the game you were last playing, resuming right where you left off! Redeal Counter Games with a limited number of redeals now show you how many redeals you have left. Next Card Note Some games require a specific card on a specific spot. Those games now show you what card you need next for each spot! Favorite Games Mark games as a Favorite now and then choose to only see your favorite games. Victory Images You can now exclude victory images you don't want to see. You also have a greater chance now of seeing the Uber Rare and Mythical images! I've also added 1 new victory image. Game Chooser Search for a game now by typing it's name, which also searches other names a game may be known as. A new "Grid" mode is now also available in the Game Chooser! You can also now sort games by various things. Background Colors You can now choose a solid background color from 24 different colors. Luck, and Complexity Games are now rated by Luck and Complexity in addition to Duration and Odds. These are now shown as helpful 'signal bars' and color coded to quickly see if it's good or bad. Larger Leaderboards Leaderboards now show 50 people each instead of just 15 or 25. Score Games now have more accurate scoring and there is an "Average Score" statistic now. Reset Stats You can now reset your statistics on a per game basis. Auto Play Auto Play is a bit smarter now. If it makes a move for you, and then you drag that card back to where it was, it will no longer auto play it right back again. Far less annoying :) Consistent Bases Games now have more consistent bases. If a card can be dropped somewhere, it will have a base with an outline, otherwise that spot will be empty. HTTPS Support The website now supports encrypted HTTPS. This update took me over 6 months to create. World of Solitaire now has a new foundation that I can build upon for years to come! Sadly, the update does remove some things: With any big change, some folks won't like the changes and would prefer things remain the same. Good news, the "old" version will always be playable here: legacy.worldofsolitaire.com Note: Statistics, logins and challenges are not available in the "legacy" version. I plan on testing the new update for a few days/weeks and then launch some time in January! This week, World of Solitaire turns 10 years old! Can you believe how fast time flies? I hope you've all had a great time playing and I hope you all continue to have fun :) Greetings! The Victory Image system has received a major overhaul! In the old system, it was difficult to discover Rare and Mythical images. Your odds of seeing them were very low. Here is the new system: Victory Images are now grouped into levels, with 5 images per level. Once you discover all the images from Level 1, you unlock Level 2. When you win, a random unlocked level is chosen and then a random image from that level. You can increase the chance of discovering new images by winning games. Each time you win a game, you'll raise a bonus chance of seeing new images. Thus the longer you play and win without seeing a new image, the easier it will become to discover a new image. You can still prevent images from showing by simply clicking on them to X them out. I also fixed some bugs with that and now it should work much more reliably. This new system should make it much easier to discover new images. In addition it should hopefully feel more rewarding as you 'level up'. Lastly I plan on adding a lot more victory images in the future and this system makes it easier to do that. I hope you all continue to enjoy playing :) Robert Hello! I have added an exciting new feature to World of Solitaire: Challenges! Challenges are pre-shuffled, numbered deals that are guaranteed to be winnable. Each challenge is rated for difficulty: Easy, Medium or Hard. Each time you play a specific challenge number, the same cards will be dealt in the same order. So you can keep trying a specific challenge until you find a way to solve it. Test your skills and see how many you can solve! Challenges can be found in the top left 'Solitaire' menu, click on 'Challenges...'. If you are a registered player and you win a challenge with the fewest moves or shortest time, then your name will appear on that challenge entry for all to see. Challenges are only available for a few different game types right now. If people like them, I can add more game types in the future. Also, I can add more challenges for each game if people solve the current ones are looking for more. I hope you all continue to have a lot of fun playing :)
