Body Parts & Spanish Definite Articles To sound more natural, there is a small grammar rule that you must keep in mind when using these terms. Unlike English, in Spanish, we rarely use possessive adjectives when talking about body parts. With this set of words, we use definite articles (el, los, la, las) to express possession. You just have to remember that, in Spanish, names of parts of the body are more likely to be accompanied by the definite articles el, la, los and las (meaning the) instead of the usual English possessive adjectives like my, your, our or their.For example: Me duele/le/le.(My/foot hurts./Profjassassmanos con guantes.(Protectyours hands with gloves./However, Spanish doesnt shy away from using possessive adjectives when things need to be clear.Sus brazos son atlcticos.(Hisarms are athletic./Sal detuy pecho.(Get it offyour chest./Additionally, there are situations when Spanish uses the definite article, but English doesnt the possessive adjective.Ten los ojos azules.(I have blue eyes.)
