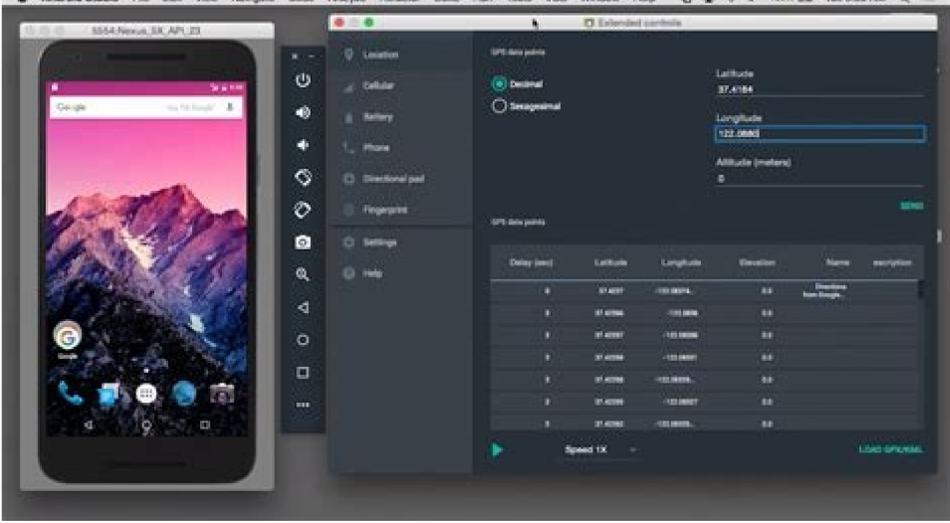

First of all, I love the content of this app and appreciate the developers who made it a reality, so I hope that the low rating and subsequent announcements will only help the platform grow. My biggest complaint is how painful it is to switch between devices. I want to pick up where I left off on my iPad when I switch to my MacBook and then back. I'm thankful that history seems to sync (mostly), but in the intended scenario, I usually have to search through a book to find where I've been on the other device. The irony is that the highlight seems so clear that the location does too. Also (another big problem) I like to have multiple books. Work your way through, but you'll often open a number of other books for reference throughout the day. This led to complete disaster in my story. It would be nice to have more books pinned at the top of the history view, or at least have filtering and sorting options so those books don't get lost in the shuffle. Of course, you can delete the rest, but then you lose the impression that you mentioned the book earlier, so that's only half the solution to the unresolved problem. When I first faced layoffs more than a quarter of a century ago, I realized that I knew absolutely nothing about the market. I vowed never to be in that situation again and made it a habit to read one textbook a month. It cost me \$40-\$50, but it was worth it. As with programming skills, the problem with reference books is that knowledge rots. Every few years you need to brush up on the tools you already know and learn new skills. Worse, a new project at work can figure out which books to buy. There is no time to research, no time to shop or wait for a book. internet time! I discovered O'Reilly ten years ago. thousands of books. Again and again. Preprints of unpublished books. Paradise! New project? Read 2-3 books and read the most important chapters. Learn technology and then pick an intermediate book that grabs your attention. Update? Read the latest version of a classic book about your favorite technology. Online courses and special streaming events? Bonus. If you're an employer and you haven't bought this for your employees, hang your head in shame for 10 minutes, fix it. If you're a techie, don't rely on your employer - get your own subscription and your reading lists will never expire. Do what I did and take responsibility for your own education. I do not recommend using the app at all. The app used to be an extension of the web where you could easily find what you needed. off. Now only Trending, Upcoming Meetings, Recommended for You and Recently Added are available. There is no history of what you read or watched online. There is a playlist tab, but this is a poor substitute for browsing history*, as it means that users who frequently search for several different technologies now have to save each result to a playlist. If you are lucky enough to work with only one domain and it uses modern technologies, the application may be suitable. But to anyone who has used O'Reilly Media as a technical reference library, I would suggest you save yourself the time and trouble and skip this app. *. The history feature also doesn't work in the web interface, so I'm not sure if their educational platform as a whole is worth the money. It's been broken for a few months and I think that's a pretty telling sign. Here is a media company whose main focus is publishing technical literature with a focus on software development.
