Indycar 500 practice

The NTT Indycar Series drivers have descended upon Indianapolis, Indiana for day two of Indy 500 practice at the iconic Indianapolis Motor Speedway. The track's 2.5-mile circuit has been put to the test by some of the world's top open-wheel racing talent. On Thursday, Scott McLaughlin topped the speed charts with an average lap speed of 232.686mph during the first session of official Indy 500 testing. However, Kyle Larson's day was cut short after he crashed into the outside wall on his only lap of the session. Here are the top 10 drivers from both sessions: **Day 1** 1. Alex Palou - 227.546 mph 2. Will Power - 225.584 mph 3. Josef Newgarden - 225.545 mph **Thursday Session (Day 2)** 1. Scott McLaughlin - 232.686mph 2. Takuma Sato - 232.565mph 3.
